

North Pacific Coast Team Qualifying Procedure Slow Pitch Program

(Central Cal, Nor Cal, Oakland, Sacramento, San Francisco, San Joaquin)

December 19, 2010

Men's Program

Men's B teams are required to participate in one (1) North Pacific Coast ASA events prior to attending their National Championships.

Men's C, D and E teams are required to participate in a minimum of two (2) North Pacific Coast ASA events to be eligible to participate in the ASA North Pacific Coast Finals. Once a team has participated in two (2) North Pacific Coast ASA events and the ASA North Pacific Coast Finals they will then be eligible to proceed to their appropriate ASA National Championships. If a team is **Officially** entered into a event and that event is cancelled that team will receive credit for participation. Once a team is eligible for ASA Championship play, the roster they submit for the ASA North Pacific Coast Finals will also be their roster used for their ASA National Championships. Teams will be allowed 3 pick-up players based on ASA Code.

Women's Program

Women's Open, C and D teams are required to participate in a minimum of two (2) North Pacific Coast ASA events to be eligible to participate in the ASA North Pacific Coast Finals. Once a team has participated in two (2) North Pacific Coast ASA events and the ASA North Pacific Coast Finals they will then be eligible to proceed to their appropriate ASA National Championships. If a team is **Officially** entered into a event and that event is cancelled that team will receive credit for participation. Once a team is eligible for ASA Championship play, the roster they submit for the ASA North Pacific Coast Finals will also be their roster used for their ASA National Championships. Teams will be allowed 3 pick-up players based on ASA Code.

Quick Reminder

If a player participates in the ASA North Pacific Coast Finals with a team that **is** proceeding to Championship play the player is only allowed to play with this team. The player cannot be dropped from the roster and added to another team proceeding to Championship play. If a player participates with a team in the ASA North Pacific Coast Finals that is **not** proceeding to Championship play, then the player could be added as a pick-up player if within Player Classification guidelines.
